The Judicial Council was asked to hear the case of ECC Wren v. Parra-Fitch and Ureña regarding the claiming of endorsements without the use of the proper disclaimers. The plaintiff and the defendants have come to an agreement regarding this case which is attached to the end of this document. The Judicial Council has accepted this agreement and issues one censure to each of the defendants for the violation of Title IV, Article 12 Section 6.7.¹

¹ Title IV, §12.6.7 “Claiming endorsements without bearing the disclaimer, “Titles for Identification Purposes Only” in the same size font as the majority of the text of the endorsements is written.”
