Solicitor General Kozak v. Shams

The Judicial Council was asked to hear the case of SG Kozak v. Shams regarding the illegal use of ASUC resources for campaign purposes. The plaintiff and the defendant have come to an agreement regarding this case, which is attached to the end of this document. The Judicial Council has accepted this agreement and issues three censures to the defendant for the violation of Title IV, Article 12 Section 3.6.¹

¹ Title IV, §12.3.6 “Using ASUC authority, facilities, funds, or resources, including Eshleman Hall, for campaign purposes, including for long term or bulk storage of campaign materials.”

Request for Settlement

SG Kozak v. Shams

The plaintiff (SG Alex Kozak) and defendant (Nadir Shams) have come to terms on an agreement resolving SG Kozak v. Shams pending approval by the Judicial Council. The terms are as follows:

- The maximum of three (3) censures to be issued to the defendant for a violation of Section 12.3.6, with the remedy specified in Section 12.10.4.
- Presentation of a letter signed by every ASUC sponsored student group listed in the charge sheet acknowledging endorsements for Nadir Shams in the '07-08 election. These letters are to be presented to next year's Senate and a present Executive ASUC office for review.
- Acknowledgment by Nadir Shams that he has the obligation to help inform candidates and student groups of their election restrictions in Title II for the next year's election season.

The defendant (Nadir Shams) wishes to make clear that there was no malicious intent behind this violation.

The plaintiff (SG Alex Kozak) recommends that the Council take this remedy as a resolution to SG vs. Nadir Shams as per the JRPs, Section 3.14.2
